- 2. **Wear upper garment of thin, natural fibre** such as a T-shirt that is long enough to reach at least to hip level and will not ride up above the belt.

After Swallowing the PillCam SB Capsule

The Capsule Endoscopy procedure will last approximately 8-9 hours. Contact your doctor's office immediately if you suffer from any abdominal pain, nausea or vomiting during the procedure.

- 1. You may drink colourless liquid starting 2 hours after swallowing the PillCam SB capsule.
- 2. You may have a light snack 4 hours after ingestion. After examination is completed, you may return to your normal diet.
- 3. Be sure the Sensor Belt is tight at the waist. Do not attach anything to it.
- **4.** Check the blue flashing Data Recorder light every 15minutes to be sure it is blinking twice per second. If it stops blinking or changes colour, note time and contact your doctor.
- 5. Use the supplied *Capsule Endoscopy Event Form* to note the time of any event such as eating, drinking or a change in your activity. Return the completed Event Form to your doctor at the time you return the equipment.
- **6. Avoid strong electromagnetic fields** such as MRI devices or ham radios after swallowing the capsule until you pass it in a bowel movement
