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## Patient Instructions for PillCam Small Bowel Capsule Endoscopy with the Sensor Belt

To ensure the best results for your PillCam- capsule endoscopy of the small bowel, follow your doctor's instructions carefully and completely.

# Day before Capsule Endoscopy Test

#### STEP 1

#### Start the prescribed liquid diet from 12 noon before the test

e.g water, cordial, soft drink, black tea, coffee (No milk, sugar is OK, fruit juice(apple and grape juice) lucozade/ sport drinks and Yellow Jelly, Bonox, clear soup must be strained with no particles. (no red, purple nor green coloured liquids)

STEP 2 The afternoon before the test at 3-4pm

#### Take the Picoprep

Mix the Sachet of Picosalax in 1 glass of water followed by 4 glasses of clear liquids as listed above between 3-4 pm.



#### STEP 3

Do not eat or drink except for necessary medication with sip of water, 10 hours before your capsule endoscopy ie from 10pm the night before your test.

## Day of Capsule Endoscopy Test

- 1. Do not take any medications 2 hours before having the exam.
- 2. Wear upper garment of thin, natural fibre such as a T-shirt that is long enough to reach at least to hip level and will not ride up above the belt.
- 3. Arrive for your appointment at the scheduled time:

### After Swallowing the PillCam SB Capsule

The Capsule Endoscopy procedure will last approximately 8-9 hours. Contact your doctor's office immediately if you suffer from any abdominal pain, nausea or vomiting during the procedure.

- 1. You may drink colourless liquid starting 2 hours after swallowing the PillCam SB capsule.
- 2. You may have a light snack 4 hours after ingestion. After examination is completed, you may return to your normal diet.
- 3. Be sure the Sensor Belt is tight at the waist. Do not attach anything to it.
- 4. **Check the blue flashing Data Recorder light every 15minutes** to be sure it is blinking twice per second. If it stops blinking or changes colour, note time and contact your doctor.
- 5. Use the supplied *Capsule Endoscopy Event Form* to note the time of any event such as eating, drinking or a change in your activity. Return the completed Event Form to your doctor at the time you return the equipment.
- 6. **Avoid strong electromagnetic fields** such as MRI devices or ham radios after swallowing the capsule until you pass it in a bowel movement
